Before you start

Things you need to attach your brandnew canopy:





13 MM Wrench/Spanner



Grease for sensitive parts (metal on metal)







Icons that will appear through out the guide




Ouch! Be careful, you could hurt your fingers.




Grease. Remember to grease or else your mechanic will hate you later on.



Important message from Larry the King.



Components



1: Canopy cover




2: Sidebars



3: Top sun screens









5: Back protection




6: Side sun screens



Step1

Two tips before you start attaching the Canopy:





Raise your handlebar to the max to make room for the canopy.



Before attaching the canopy frame removethe two bolts inside the canopy. Use tools 1+2.

The bolts fits the Canopy onto the actual bicycle frame. Fit them when you finish Step2.

King Larry says: "If you have bought the Bullitt Childseat and want to attach it inside the Canopy you remove the bolts and attach the child seat to the back holes instead"



Fitting the canopy the onto the frame:






Unfold the cover, remove all strips and place it on the bike. Backside of the cover facing the steerer assembly.



Drag the cover backwards towards the steerer assembly.




Fit the hook (A) on the front of the canopy onto the frame and the pin (B) into the back hole on the bottom of the frame.



Attach the velcro on the bicycle frame.


Step3

Assembling the roof bars:





Bend the bars on the roof of the canopy into position. Be careful - you could cut your fingers!




Tighten the screws with hex/alan key tool and repeat step 3 on the opposite side of the canopy.




Bottom view.


Assembling the side bars:





Get your Sidebars. Unscrew the bolts. Notice that the bolts are slightly different. A one goes in hole D on the frame.










...not like this.

Step5

Attaching the cover to the side bars:






Attach the rubbers to the straps.



Attach the flaps in the following order.



Put the velcro strap through the hole.




And attach it like disssss!



Viola! Finished!

Attach the cover to the roof bars:





Zip the sides of the windows and attach the velcro so its nice and tight. Do it on both sides of the canopy.



Put the velcro straps through the hole and attach it. Repeat on the opposite side.




Important notice from The King Larry.
When you get to this stage, the best thing is to leave the Canopy to rest for 24 hrs. It's so the fabric can stretch. If not patient...





We make the only side entrance Canopy in the universe and it has a prize. The prize is patience.



Bend the cover back and you are good to go.

Step7

Mounting the back protection:






Match the the red velcro to the inside backof the canopy cover.




Attach the velcro.



Fitting the sun screen to the side:





Get your sun screen.




On the inside top back corner is a button. Find it and match it with the button on the sun screen.




Attach the velcro on the Sun screen onto the inside of the flap all the way to the front of the "window". Finish by clicking the button at the front on to the canopy inside

Step9

Attaching the roof:





Attach the velcro hinges on the Sun screen onto the outside of the canopy.

Get your roof and Fit the holes (A) on to the back of the canopy on both sides.



Roll it forward.



Attach the two buttons on the inside roof to the two sun screens.



Stretch it forward and attach the holes on each side on to the taps of the front canopy.



And attach the velcro at the end to the canopy.
